Perfect Party Guide

Perfect Party Guide – Our top 12 tips for the perfect party!

- 1** For a better controlled party, when choosing a party venue try and choose a hall that comfortably suits your attendance numbers without being too big, as large empty spaces encourages children to run around more.
- 2** If your party venue is set back off the road, balloons tied around a nearby tree or lamp post is a great way to let your guest know where the party is.
- 3** Don't forget to check your camera's memory space and batteries a couple of days before the party. Also, assigning a family member or friend to take photos at the party leaves you to concentrate on the party itself.
- 4** If possible, limit the amount of parents staying at the party; this allows the entertainer to be heard over chatty parents as well as the children being keener to get involved as there are fewer parents to cling to.
- 5** Avoid putting out lots of empty chairs around the venue as this encourages more children to sit out of party games.
- 6** Setting out the food table running down the venue as opposed to across it allows more room for team games.
- 7** Balloons on walls make great decoration, but avoid leaving balloons lying around the venue floor as this will inevitably result in children hitting each other over the head with them and being burst.
- 8** Putting name stickers on the children as they arrive allows your entertainer to create a much more fun and friendly bond with the children.
- 9** For younger guests consider making a note of their parent's mobile number in case they become upset at missing them or in the event of an emergency.
- 10** Attaching their favourite character helium balloon to the back of the birthday child's chair and seating them in the middle of the table, is a great way to make him or her feel special at food time.
- 11** Bringing out the birthday cake and singing 'Happy Birthday' after the food (approx. halfway through the party) allows you plenty of time to cut and wrap the birthday cake ready to pop into party bags.
- 12** If you are planning on giving out party bags let your Entertainer know before the end of the party, so that he can inform the children before they leave.
